#### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board of Commissioners approve the General Manager and the Controller to amend the FY 2021-22 Capital and Operating Budget by unfunding less vital capital projects to fund more critical operational and capital needs, which are further detailed in (Exhibit 1)

And

It is recommended that the Board of Commissioners approve the General Manager and the Controller to utilize unrestricted Capital Connection Fees to cover the SRF loan payment shortcoming of \$609,176.

#### **PREVIOUS ACTION(S)**

On June 17, 2021, the VVWRA Board of Commissioners approved the FY 2021-22 Budget.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The current Mid-Year budget review reflects a balanced budget to date and expected revenues and expenses are on track to meet fiscal year budgeted needs. Due to unforeseen operational and capital needs Staff is recommending that the Board approve unfunding several, less vital, capital projects and utilizing those dollars to fund two new more critical projects and operational budget needs. In amending the budget staff is requesting that two new capital projects be approved and funded during this fiscal year. The first project is the replacement of the Aqua Diamond filter media and an upgrade to the PLC controls for that asset. This filter media has been in service for over seven years and has reached the end of its useful life. The second project that needs to be developed is attributed to the future Victorville Wellness Center which is in design and will ultimately be constructed in Old Town Victorville along the Mojave River adjacent to Eva Dell Park. VVWRA currently has a 36-inch pipeline and a 15-foot easement that runs through the middle of the project. Due to existing capacity concerns VVWRA has identified the need for a future parallel pipeline to be installed in that same location. The City of Victorville and VVWRA staff are working together to design and install this parallel pipeline during construction to avoid a future disturbance in the operations of the facility. The current proposed funding will pay for the design of the pipeline. Additional funds were also needed for the Oro Grande pump station and pipeline project to qualify for future grants.

Unfunded dollars from capital projects are also needed to cover unexpected costs in the operational budget. There is a need to add additional dollars to the natural gas account for the 2G generators due to the conversion from methane to natural gas for the RNG project. The second operational budget line item that is significantly higher than expected is insurance related costs. These cost increases were reported to staff after the finalizing of the budget and as such we are now short on funding to cover the new costs.

During the mid-year budget review staff also identified a shortcoming in the amount of connection fee revenues that the Agency has projected to receive. Some of this shortcoming can be attributed to the COVID pandemic limiting development within the member agencies jurisdiction. At this time the current balance of connection fees projected to be received are not sufficient to cover the pending SRF loan payment of \$2,133,072. Staff is requesting the Board to approve the General Manager and the Controller to utilize unrestricted Capital Connection Fees to cover the SRF loan payment shortcoming of \$609,176. The breakdown and current availability of current Connection Fees is detailed in the following calculations:

These changes reflect necessary fiscally responsible decisions by staff to change plans to meet immediate needs within the approved budgetary limits. It is for this reason that staff recommends that the Board of Commissioners approve the General Manager and the Controller to amend the FY 2021-22 Capital and Operating Budget by unfunding less vital capital projects to fund more critical operational and capital needs; and allow the use of unrestricted connection fee reserves to cover the SRF loan payment during FY2022.

#### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board of Commissioners authorize the General Manager to purchase and install new media and PLCs for the AquaDiamond filters from Misco Water for \$272,900.00 plus a 5% contingency, to cover unforeseen costs, totaling \$287,000.00.

#### **PREVIOUS ACTION(S)**

November 20, 2014, the Board of Commissioners Approved the purchase of AquaDiamond OptiFibre 5-micron Polyester Tertiary Filter Cloth Media, as Sole Source from Aqua-Aerobic Systems, to upgrade from the 10 micron media that was initially installed.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Since the installation of the 5-micron media in November 2014 the AquaDiamond filters have been running as expected with no issues. In November 2021 we started seeing increased filter effluent turbidity that could jeopardize compliance. Upon inspection we found notable signs of wear, which is expected as the life expectancy of the media is 7 years. Aqua-Aerobics was contacted, and temporary repairs were made per their suggestion until new media can be installed.

The Aquadiamond filters are controlled by two programmable logic controllers (PLCs). These two PLCs were installed in 2012, as part of the original installation, and are now obsolete. During the downtime for the changeout of the media, the PLCs would be upgraded to current models.

On November 30, 2021, VVWRA received quotes from Misco Water for the replacement of the media and the PLC's (Exhibit 1). It is recommended that the Board of Commissioners authorize the General Manager to purchase and install new media and PLCs for the Aquadiamond filters. This is a sole source purchase as Misco Water is the sole vendor for Aqua Aerobics products in this region (Exhibit 2).

Based on these findings Staff recommends that the Board of Commissioners authorize the General Manager to purchase and install new media and PLCs for the AquaDiamond filters from Misco Water for \$272,900.00 plus a 5% contingency, to cover unforeseen costs, totaling \$287,000.00.

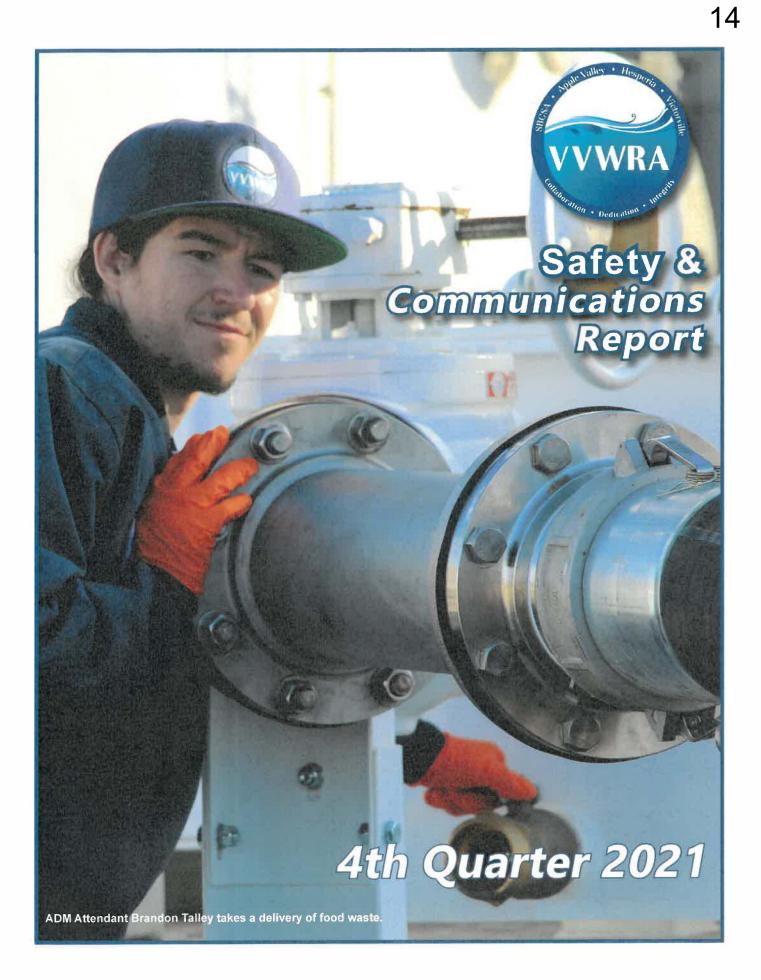

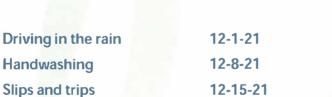

# New streamlined FOG permitting process for Victor Valley business

Victor Valley Wastewater Reclamation Authority (VVWRA) and its member agencies are streamlining the pretreatment permitting process for local food service establishments (\*FSE's).

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As of October 1, 2021, VVWRA no longer offers pretreatment permitting of FSE's and has transferred the responsibility of permitting to the Authority's member agencies, which include the Town of Apple Valley, the City of Hesperia, the City of Victorville and San Bernardino County.

The change removes a duplication of services and will make the permit process easier. Pretreatment permitting program is designed to regulate the discharge of fats, oils, and grease (FOG) from FSE's into the sewer system. FOG is a leading cause of sewer clogs and overflows.

VVWRA maintains 45 miles of main sewer trunk lines, while business and residential sewer lines are maintained by our member agencies. "The change in the permit process will help better monitor and protect the sewer lines in our member agencies communities", said VVWRA General Manager Darron Poulsen. "This is a cooperative agreement that better serves the Victor Valley and the business community."

\*FSE's can include, but are not limited to, restaurants, commercial kitchens, caterers, hotels, bakeries, donut shops, public and private schools, hospitals, prisons, correctional facilities, and care institutions.
